Opportunities: Our team will partner with former International Missionary Church Planter, **Rodney Duncan** and **Kajang Baptist Fellowship** to assist them in ministering love, hope and the Truth of the gospel to people near **Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia**. This is the capital city of Malaysia. 95% of Rodney's ministry is with English speaking people.

Positioned at the intersection of the Gombak and Klang rivers in Malaysia, Kuala Lumpur (often called "KL") is literally translated as "muddy estuary." KL started out as a sleepy, sludgy river town in its tin mining days. Today, rather than mud, you'll find sleek skyscrapers, manicured parks, and busy expressways rising up around its rivers.

Kuala Lumpur is a diverse city with a blend of Chinese, Indian, and Malay cultures along with a large expat community from all over the world. That said, there is a substantial Western influence in Malaysia—and in Kuala Lumpur in particular. Many Western expats who move to KL say they had surprisingly little culture shock. In almost any place, you can find someone who speaks English. Malaysia is proud of its multi-faith culture. (Many people worship many different gods and religions. The same festive lights will be put up in the offices and condos for Ramadan, Deepavali, and Christmas. Rodney and other Christ-followers from his church are sharing the gospel and helping people come to meet the one true God!

What will we be doing? Depending on the gifts, talents, abilities and interest of those who join the team, we will be sharing God's love and the hope of Jesus through many different ways such as:

*Ministry with University Students – Bible studies, BBQ block party, free laundry night, transportation to games, gift bags, evangelism, random acts of kindness

*Park ministry targeting parents and children, teens, neighbors, seniors with sports, group games, crafts, Bible stories/skits and music!



*Assist in teaching English through the Bible for people who want to improve their English speaking and reading skills!

*Ministry to the Homeless: Feeding, praying, testimonies, singing, loving!

*Acts of Kindness and service in the community such as window washing local businesses as an appreciation and ministry!

*Evangelism and Prayer walking!

TRIP COST: The basic price of the trip is your air-fare plus approximately \$400 to \$475. This includes insurance, in-country transportation, lodging, meals, orientation materials, and T-shirt. You will want to take extra money for snacks and souvenirs you may want to buy. Most recent searches for air-fare have found rates \$900.00 to \$1000.00. That would make the total cost approximately \$1300. to \$1400. **A deposit of \$200 and your completed mission team form will hold your spot.** Once applications and deposits have been received, we will order your airline ticket.

TEAM: We can take up to 14 people. Great Mission Trip for first timers! Awesome trip for all ages! Those under the age of 16 must have a parent with them.

HEALTH: Team members must be in good physical health. Anyone with a chronic medical condition should not volunteer for this trip. We will be doing a lot of walking. Many areas of work will be outdoors and strenuous. Vaccinations may be required. We will have access to safe drinking water. There are good doctors and medical facilities in the area in case of emergency.

LIVING AND WORKING CONDITIONS: . Those participating in this effort must be flexible and willing to work as a member of the team. Travel, living, and working conditions may be difficult at times. The work may be strenuous and the climate will be between 80 - 85 degrees. Our team will prepare most of our own meals.

PREPARATIONS:

#3. Attend team meetings!! Our team will meet together several times for orientation, training, prayer and Bible study prior to leaving.

#4. You will also need to have a valid US Passport. It is also recommended that you take a valid picture I.D, preferably driver's license. Also, if you are not a U.S. citizen, and have an alien registration card, you will need to show your legal documents to be admitted back into the States.

OTHER: Smoking, chewing tobacco, and drinking alcoholic beverages is not allowed.
