Each week a speaker will present subjects relating to womanhood, marriage, child rearing and relationships. An informal time of refreshments and fellowship followed by a creative activity time, allows for an atmosphere to nurture honest interaction, deepening friendships & spiritual enrichment.

Financial Information...

The budget for MOPS comes from registration dues, and is divided up to cover all the costs. These funds are used primarily for MOPS to MOM connection, and craft costs (including MOPPETS). There is an annual non-refundable registration fee of \$25.00 due at the time you sign up (this goes to MOPS International). There are also semester dues of \$25.00 which should be paid at the first meeting. There are two semesters a year.
