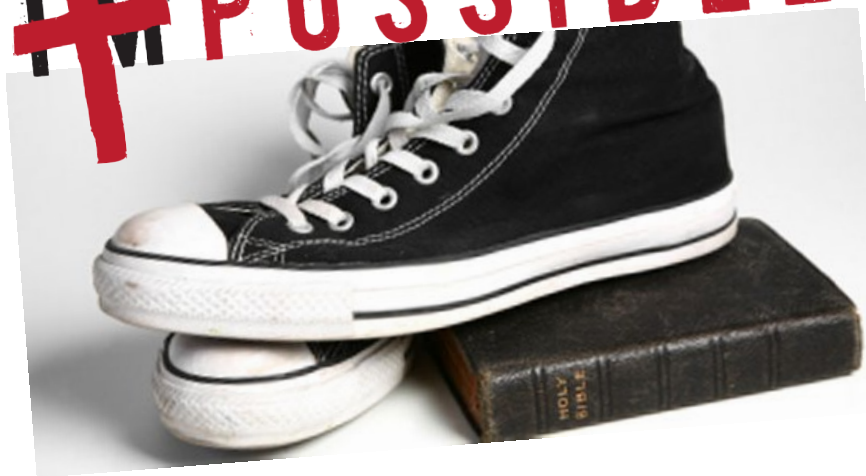

### **Children and their families**

1. Pray for the salvation of children and family members who are lost. Ask God to open their eyes to their sin and need for a Savior.
2. Pray that parents will understand their role as the spiritual leaders of their children. Pray that fathers especially would walk close with Christ and lead their family by example. Pray that children would learn to read their Bible, pray and have a personal relationship with God by SEEING the example set from their parents.
3. Ask God to protect our children from satan's attacks. Ask God to deliver them from temptation. Pray against the influence of sinful media, video games, pornography, violence and disrespect.
4. Pray that children who are saved accept God's call on their life to use their gifts, talents, time and abilities at an early age to glorify Jesus.
5. Pray that children will be equipped to share the good news about Jesus with other children. Ask God to use our kids to make more disciples!
6. Pray that boys and girls understand the difference in knowing ABOUT God and actually knowing God through a personal relationship with Jesus. Pray that they love God's Word, enjoy reading it, and understand what God is saying to them.

7. Pray that our children will understand and participate in both talking to God and listening to God in prayer. Ask God to raise up powerful prayer warriors in the lives of our boys and girls.
8. Pray for families who are struggling with separation and divorce. Pray that moms and dads would surrender their lives completely to Christ and do whatever it takes to restore broken relationships. Pray for protection of children's hearts and minds during these difficult times.
9. Pray for children and families who have someone in the home struggling with addiction. There are so many parents, teens and preteens who are chained to an addiction that is ruling over their life and set on a course with destruction. Ask God to open their eyes to the Truth. Pray that they will be set free by surrendering to Jesus. Pray that God brings to light what is being hidden in the darkness. Ask God to protect children who find themselves victims in these homes.
10. Pray for our Shine Time Teachers, Awana Leaders and Children's Ministry staff and volunteers, asking God to use us in powerful ways to influence and help children and families walk with God and seek Him first.

## **Praying for God's Direction (God's Will) for your life**

### **God leads us through His written Word.**

Psalm 119:105 Your word is a lamp to my feet and a light to my path.

In the Bible when you see the phrase, "This is the will of God" you know you can count on His Word and His Will for this is His Truth.

- Pray asking God to lead you to the scriptures that will show you what is His Will for your life. In Philippians 4:7, Paul tells of "the peace of God" that guards and guides our hearts and our minds.
- Pray asking God to make you alert and aware of conditions and situations around you, to give you discernment.
- Pray asking The Father to show you from His Word, the direction you are to take.

### **We know God leads through the prompting of the Holy Spirit.**

So then, my beloved, just as you have always obeyed, not as in my presence only, but now much more in my absence, work out your salvation with fear and trembling; for it is God who is at work in you, both to will and to work for His good pleasure. [Philippians 2:12-13](#)

The Holy Spirit gives us a sense of God's leading; it is how He gives us an "at-peace" in what He is leading or not leading us to do.

The mind of man plans his way, But the LORD directs his steps. [Proverbs 16:9](#)

- Pray asking to know the Holy Spirit's nudging, when you are standing still or moving in the wrong direction.
- Pray asking for your mind and emotions to be calmed and not confusing so you can hear clearly and be led in the direction the Father is leading.
- Pray with confidence in the Father's leading and in His direction for your life.

### **God leads us into His will by giving us an inner assurance of peace.**

Paul wrote "Let the peace of Christ rule in your hearts, to which indeed you were called in one body; and be thankful" [Colossians 3:15](#).

- Pray asking for God's leading to know and walk in His Will.
- Pray asking for inner peace from God as you walk the path that God is directing
- Pray asking the Father to help you to live out His Will in your daily life.
- Pray asking for faith and courage in following the direction for your life the Lord has planned.

[Hebrews 11:6](#) tells us that "without faith it is impossible to please Him, for he who comes to God must believe that He is and that He is a rewarder of those who seek Him."
